Gabriele Cosmi was born in 1988.

He obtained his composition studies, with highest honors, at the Conservatorio Giuseppe Verdi in Milan with Alessandro Solbiati. Essential for its formation the meeting with Ivan Fedele with whom he graduated at the Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia in Rome, with the highest honors.

In 2014 he was selected by the Comitè de Lecture of Ircam to attend the Cursus 1.
